



## **Domtar Achieves FSC Certification at Four Additional Paper Mills**

Domtar Corporation announced today that it has achieved Forest Stewardship Council (FSC) Chain-of-Custody [certification](#) at four more of its paper mills. Its coated groundwood mill in Columbus, MS , and uncoated freesheet mills in Hawesville, KY , Kingsport, TN , and Marlboro (Bennettsville), SC are now FSC-certified.

The number of FSC-certified Domtar sites now exceeds 40, and includes 11 paper mills, three market pulp mills, 14 off-site converting operations, and regional replenishment centers located across its North American manufacturing footprint. Chain-of-Custody certification is a rigorous tracking system that identifies the origin of fiber used in certified products under FSC.

"The addition of these four paper operations to our FSC-certified [network](#) will enable us to expand our Domtar EarthChoice(R) line of environmentally and socially responsible paper products and bring us closer to our customers across North America ," said Lewis Fix , Senior Director, Business Development at Domtar.
